


# KETELHUIS CRUQUIUS








## When interior & exterior merge








## Taking a ride on the green side



# Furniture & space brought together


The furniture by *Studio Henk* complements the architecture. Matching materials, colour palette and some pictorial hints of contrast make an harmonious whole.














# Inside out design
